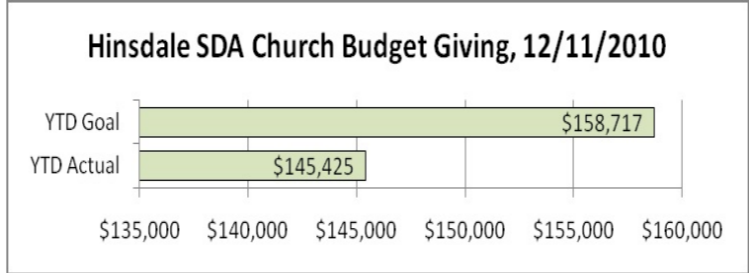
MEMORIAL SERVICE
