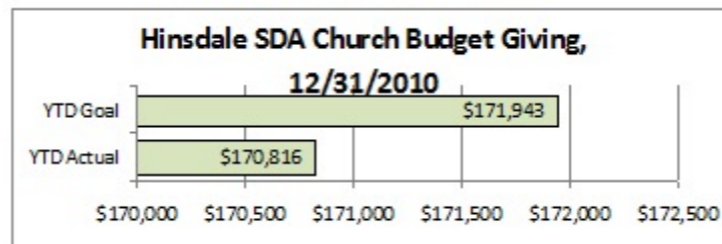
MISSION TRIP SUPPLIES NEEDED
