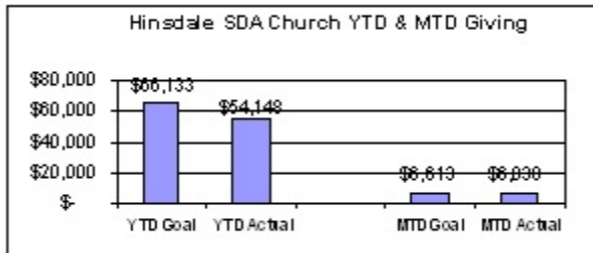
FINANCE MANAGEMENT SEMINAR
