Bill Mulske's brother passed away earlier this week. Our church family offers condolences and prayers to Bill and his family as they grieve their loss.

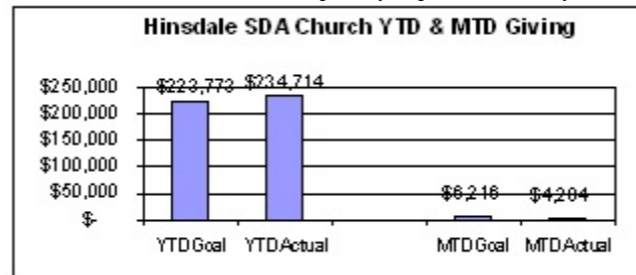
FIRST SABBATH OF EACH MONTH
