The 10/40 Window refers to those regions of the eastern hemisphere located between 10 and 40 degrees north of the equator, including North Africa, Middle East, and parts of Asia.

65% of earth's population lives in this region with Buddhism, Hinduism, and Islam represented most prominently.

1.57 billion, 23% of earth's population, are Muslim and over 80% of them live in this 10/40 Window. There are still countless people who have never heard of the gospel. For the latter rain of the Holy Spirit, the seed of present truth must be sowed.

We urge you to join us and participate in praying together for the people in the 10/40 Window regardless of your location.
